Dr. Lauren M. Smith is a native of Indianapolis, IN. She pursued her undergraduate studies at the Loyola University of New Orleans and received a medical degree from the University Of Maryland School Of Medicine. Completing her residency training at the Cook County Emergency Medicine residency program in 2006. After working in the community, she joined the emergency medicine faculty at John H. Jr. Hospital of Cook County in 2008.
